#### **CANDIDATE CRITERIA**

Candidates should be willing to honour the principles of the Te Arawa partnership with Rotorua Lakes Council and must:

- Live in Rotorua District
- Be 18 years or over
- Be enrolled on the Te Arawa Lakes Trust Register
- Indicate the seat they are standing for and be endorsed by the sector they represent
- Not be physically or mentally incapacitated to the extent that they are unable to perform the duties of a Board member
- Not be an undischarged bankrupt
- Not have been convicted of any serious offences, including against children, domestic violence, or fraud

Candidates must complete a nomination form that includes evidence of endorsement, and attach to the nomination form a headshot, and candidate statement not exceeding 200 words.

### **ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE**

Anyone wishing to vote in the Te Tatau o Te Arawa Board election must:

- Be enrolled on the Te Arawa Lakes Trust Register, and
- Be 18 years of age or over.

People not already enrolled on the register may do so by completing a registration form at least two days before voting closes. Registration forms are available from the Te Arawa Lakes Trust office or from <a href="https://www.tetatau.nz">www.tetatau.nz</a>.

### **VOTING**

The election will be carried out by postal and internet voting. Voter packs will be posted out to all registered members on **Wednesday 13 July**. **Voting closes 12 noon, Friday 5 August 2022.**
